
As has been the practice, our team comprised of monastic member/s, Ophthalmologist/s, Optometrists, Matron, nurses, Ophthalmic assistant, volunteers and driver served the villagers coordinated by Mrs. Veena Talreja. An additional feature of one camp held at Borli this year was the presence of an ENT surgeon and Physician; both of them providing their services.

Two camps were held in the villages of Alibaug:

1) Khidki on 31st October 2021

2) Borli, Murud Road on 12th December 2021.

The camp dates were notified to the villagers by handbills and announcements were made using public address system. Details of the camp were also displayed by banners at prominent places in and around the villages.
