DRAWING THEMES

FOR JUNIORS (STD. V TO VII)

1. SWAMIJI PRACTISED WHAT HE PREACHED

In one of his discourses at a Western American town, Swamiji said that one who has attained Absolute Truth or Knowledge remains the same under all circumstances; he is always calm and unruffled by things external. A few churlish cowboys heard this lecture and decided to test him. When Swamiji went to their village to deliver a lecture, they asked him to stand on a reversed tub and address the gathering.

Swamiji did as requested and then became absorbed in his subject. The cowboys meanwhile started firing from close range, the bullets whizzing past Swamiji's ears. This did not perturb Swamiji in the least. He continued his speech with as much composure as he had started with. When he had finished, the cowboys surrounded him, shook hands with him and declared : "Yes Swamiji, you are absolutely genuine. You are what you preach!"

2. INNOCENT BILEY

OR

The elders of the household had told Biley, in fun, that if one meditated, one's hair would become as long and matted as the monks', and would gradually enter deep into the earth like the roots of a banyan tree. So the simple child, seated in meditation, would once in a while open his eyes to see if his hair had grown long and matted. But when his expectations were not fulfilled, he ran in bewilderment to his mother, and asked, "I have meditated; but why has no matted hair grown?" His mother consoled him: "It is not grown in an hour or a day. It takes many many days, yes, many many months, before matted locks can be grown."

1. THE BARANAGORE MATH

After the Mahasamadhi of Sri Ramakrishna, Narendranath and his brother-disciples rented an old dilapidated house at Baranagore where they founded the first Monastery of the Ramakrishna Order. The garden was full of weeds and cobras lived under the ground floor ! For months they had nothing to eat but rice and boiled leaves. But Naren and the brother monks cared nothing for it. They thought only of God. They meditated for long hours, sang songs and discussed the religious ideas of all sects and religions. During this period they took the monastic vow of Sannyasa They tried to follow everything that Sri Ramakrishna had taught them.

2. BRAVE NAREN

OR

Once 6 year old Naren was returning from a fair with one of his younger cousins. He has purchased some Shiva idols. It was dark and they got slightly separated. At that moment, a carriage came dashing along. Naren turned at the noise and was horrified to see that it was a question of life and death for the little lad who stood terrified in the middle of the road, about to be run over! Putting the Shiva idols under his left arm, Naren rushed to him and heedless of his. own safety, pulled him almost from under the horses' hooves! Some people patted Naren for his bravery while others blessed him.

- These papers are to be evaluated by the school teachers at their respective schools.
- The schools are requested to return the evaluated papers of the three top-ranking students to us on or before **Friday, December 5, 2025 and collect the set of prescribed books, one each for three top rankers, for the following Final Round.**
- We will supply the books free to each participating school.

Final Round (At Ramakrishna Math, Khar) : on Friday, December 19, 2025

- a. The team comprising 3 top-ranking students representing their school shall participate in the Final Round of Inter - School Quiz Contest.

3. Three students of the same school have to form a group.
4. The presentation has to be made by the group.
5. The PPT has to be made in any version upto **2016**.
6. The PPT can consist of relevant photos, graphics, words and even music.
7. **Presentation can be in English/Marathi/Hindi or in combination.**
8. A Stop Sign will be displayed after **6 minutes**, when the PPT has to end.
9. Students should not continue after the Stop Sign.
10. There is no restriction on the number of slides which the group can make. However, all slides should be shown within the allotted time of **6 minutes** per group.
11. **The students have to bring their PPT in a pen-drive or in the laptop on the day of the competition.**
